CENTRE**

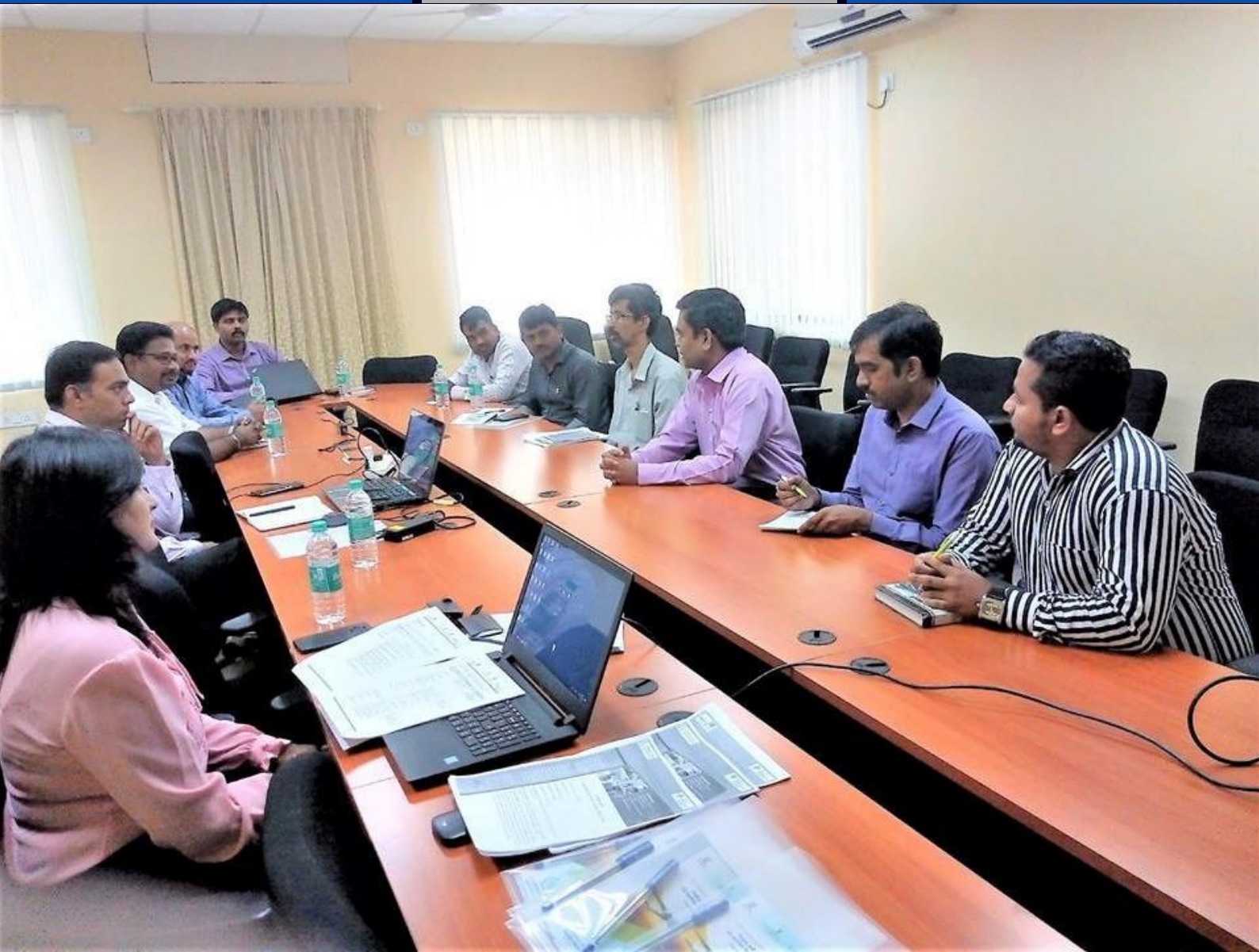
